Installation

1. Park the machine on a level surface and raise the plow a few centimeters (inches) off the ground.
2. Place a jack stand under the plow pushframe, shut off the vehicle engine, engage the parking brake, and remove the key.
3. Remove the existing cutting edges by removing the bolts, washers, and nuts that secure the cutting edges to the blades (Figure 1).

Retain the washers and nuts for future steel cutting edge installation.

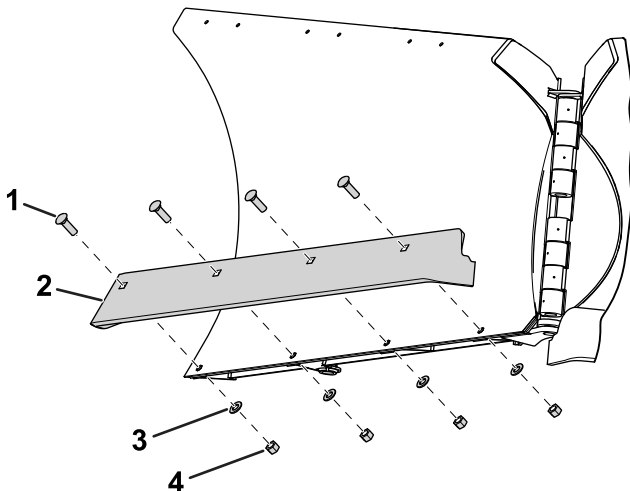

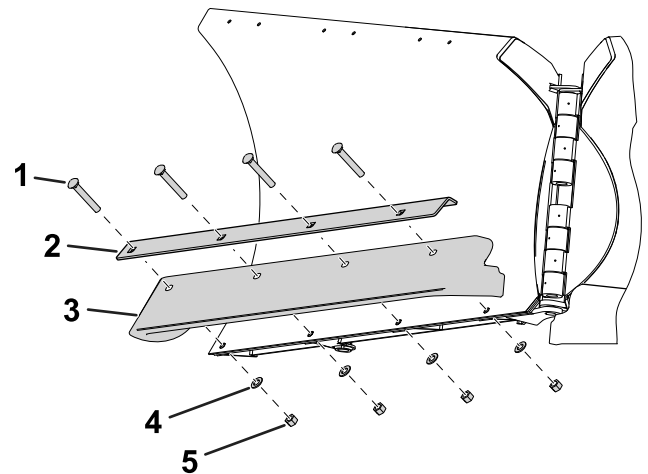


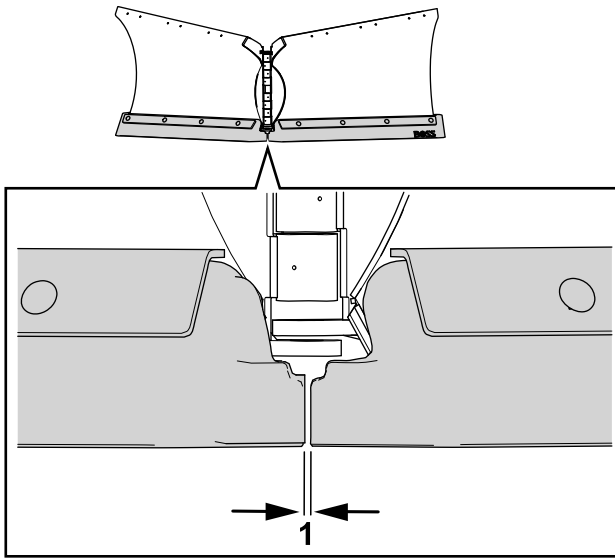

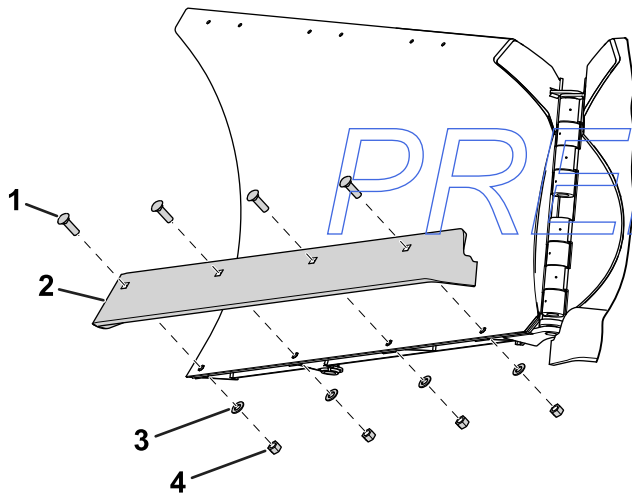

2.29 m (7-1/2 ft) or 2.5 m (8-1/6 ft) plow shown

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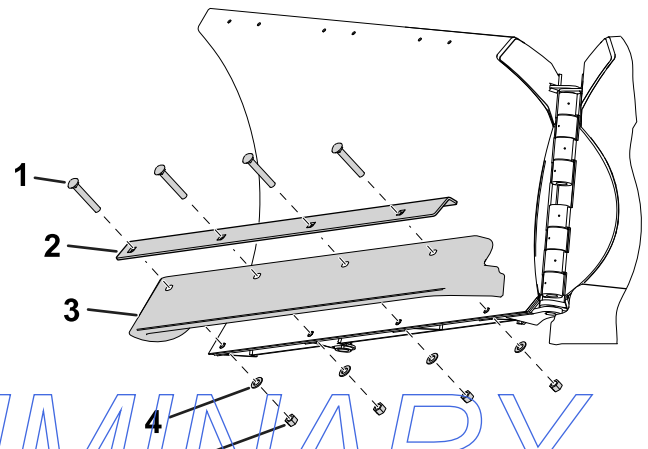


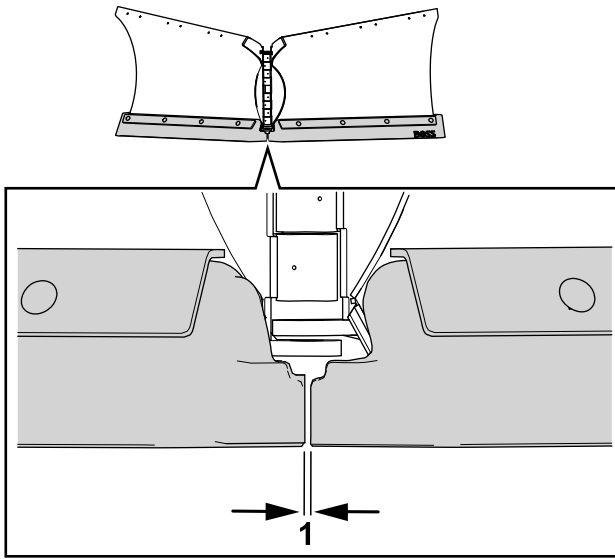

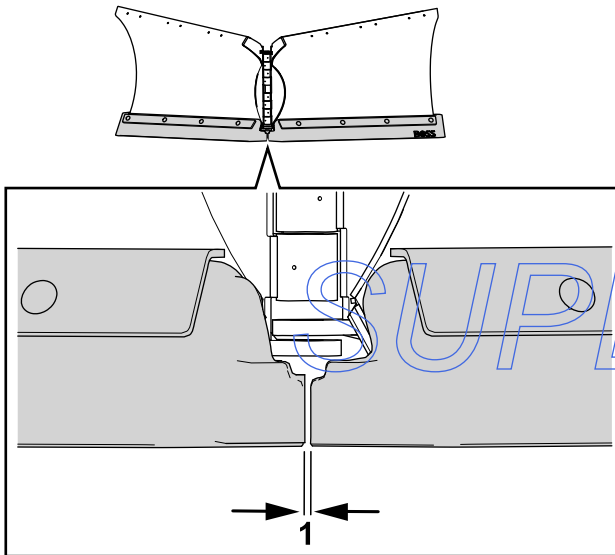
