
## **Safety**

- Always follow the vehicle manufacturer's recommendations relating to system installation.
  For recommended vehicle models, refer to the BOSS Snowplow Application Chart and Selection Guide.
- Never disable, remove, or relocate any sensors or other components related to the operation of the air bags.
- To comply with federal regulations and to assure a safe vehicle, do not exceed the front gross-axle-weight rating (FGAWR), rear gross-axle-weight rating (RGAWR), and the gross-vehicle-weight rating (GVWR) at any time.
- Due to the variety of equipment that you can install on the vehicle and undercarriage, do not exceed the front gross-axle-weight rating (FGAWR), rear gross-axle-weight rating (RGAWR), and the gross-vehicle-weight rating (GVWR) at any time. This may require weighing the vehicle and adding ballast as necessary. It may also limit the payload capacity of the vehicle.
- Do not exceed the vehicle manufacturer's recommended towing capacity.

## Installation

Determine the left and right sides of the machine from the normal operating position.

- Park the machine on a level surface, shut off the engine, wait for all moving parts to stop, engage the parking brake, and remove the key.
- Remove the wire harness clips from the vehicle hitch
- Remove the existing vehicle hitch and retain the hardware.
- On the underside of the rear of the vehicle, loosely attach the undercarriage sideplates to the frame using the previously removed fasteners (Figure 1).




Existing fasteners

5. Loosely attach the pushbeam to the sideplates using 8 bolts (1/2 inch) and locknuts (Figure 2).


**Note:** Refer to your plow *Owner's Manual* for the appropriate pushbeam height.

- 1. Bolt (1/2 inch)
- 3. Pushbeam
- 2. Locknut (1/2 inch)
- 6. Torque the 1/2-inch bolts to 76 N·m (56 ft-lb).

**Note:** Torque the existing bolts according to your vehicle manufacturer's recommendation.

- 7. Install the previously removed wire harness clips.
- 8. Install the hitch reducer, if needed.
