#### Installation Instructions

# For Straight-Blade and **HTX/Sport Plows**

#### Model MSC09215 and MSC09249

1. Assemble the casters as shown in Figure 1.



- Nut (5/16 inch)
- 2. Washers
- 3. Small caster shoe base
- Kickstand caster base
- Carriage bolt
- Nut (3/8 inch)
- Large caster
- Small caster
- Bolt (5/16 inch)
- Park the machine on a level surface, raise the 2. plow fully, and place 2 safety jack stands under the plow cutting edge.
- Shut off the engine, wait for all moving parts to stop, engage the parking brake, and remove the key.
- Slide the small caster shoes into the shoe holders on the plow and secure them with a quick pin (Figure 2).

**Note:** Adjust the number of washers above and below the shoe holder as needed.




- 4. Washers
- Remove the existing kickstand and replace it with the kickstand caster shoe (Figure 3).



- Kickstand spring pin
- Kickstand caster shoe




- 6. Fully raise the kickstand caster shoe and lock it into place with the existing kickstand spring pin (Figure 3).
- 7. Remove the safety jack stands and lower the plow.
- 8. Lower the kickstand caster shoe and lock it into place.
- 9. Follow the plowing procedures in your *Owner's Manual*.

### For XT V-Blade Plows

#### Model MSC09216

1. Assemble the casters as shown in Figure 4.

- Nut (5/16 inch)
  Washers
- 3. Small caster base
- 4. Carriage bolt
- 5. Nut (3/8 inch)
- Large caster
- 7. Small caster
- 8. Bolt (5/16 inch)
- 2. Park the machine on a level surface, raise the plow fully, and place 2 safety jack stands under the plow cutting edge.
- Shut off the engine, wait for all moving parts to stop, engage the parking brake, and remove the key.
- 4. Slide the large caster shoes into the shoe holders on the plow and secure them with a quick pin (Figure 5).

**Note:** Adjust the number of washers above and below the shoe holder as needed.



- 5. Slide the small caster shoe into the center shoe holder and secure it with a quick pin (Figure 6).

**Note:** Adjust the number of washers above and below the center bushing as needed.






# For HTX and UTV V-Blade Plows

#### Model MSC09235

1. Assemble the casters as shown in Figure 7.



- 1. Nut (5/16 inch)
- 2. Washers
- 3. Small caster base
- 4. Small caster
- 5. Bolt (5/16 inch)
- 2. Park the machine on a level surface, raise the plow fully, and place 2 safety jack stands under the plow cutting edge.
- 3. Shut off the engine, wait for all moving parts to stop, engage the parking brake, and remove the key.
- 4. Slide the small caster shoes into the shoe holders on the plow and secure them with a quick pin (Figure 8).

**Note:** Adjust the number of washers above and below the shoe holder or center bushing as needed.



- 5. Remove the safety jack stands and lower the plow in the "V" position.

## For DXT V-Blade Plows

#### Model MSC01141

1. Assemble the casters as shown in Figure 9.



- 1. Washers
- 2. Carriage bolt
- 3. Plastic knob
- 4. Center caster
- 5. Nut (3/8 inch)
- 6. Caster

- 2. Park the machine on a level surface, raise the plow fully, and place 2 safety jack stands under the plow cutting edge.
- 3. Shut off the engine, wait for all moving parts to stop, engage the parking brake, and remove the key.
- Slide the large caster shoes into the rear shoe holders on the plow and secure them with a quick pin (Figure 10).

**Note:** Adjust the number of washers above and below the shoe holder as needed.




- 1. Quick pin
- 2. Shoe holder
- 3. Large caster shoe
- 5. Partially insert the plastic knob on the center caster shoe into the plow center bushing (Figure 11).



- 1. Plastic knob
- 2. Center caster shoe

- 6. Slide the center caster shoe onto the plow center bottom plate, ensuring that the plastic knob faces forward (Figure 11).
- 7. Tighten the plastic knob to secure the center caster shoe to the plow.
- 8. Remove the safety jack stands and lower the plow in the "V" position.
- 9. Follow the plowing procedures in your *Owner's Manual*.
